At times this has made it difficult for us as a church community to

discuss how we handle abuse – there is such heightened emotion and fear around it.

In their view, I was in the wrong – no, him – because I had left. But American research provides one important insight: men who attend church less often are most likely to abuse their wives. Who else could be blamed, Peter screamed at his wife in nightly tirades, for her alleged insubordination, for her stupidity, her lack of sexual pliability, her refusal to join him on the 'Tornado' ride at a Queensland waterpark, her annoying friendship with a woman he called "Ratface"? It found that the arrest of an abusive partner reduced the rate of re-offending within the ensuing six-month period by half when compared to other, less formal police interventions.

Church leaders in Australia say they abhor abuse of any kind. In a conference for women in Sydney where domestic violence was discussed, a session on "Appreciating God's Gift of Sex" gave as one example of challenges that can "fracture the beauty of sex", along with pornography and busyness: "women calling the shots in the bedroom".
